At Priory we offer two pathways into the profession, both of which can be completed on a full or part-time basis to offer flexible training opportunities. We would be delighted to welcome you to Priory to begin your teacher training journey!

1. Schools Direct

If you want your training to be based in a school of your choice, where you can be fully immersed in the life of a teacher from day one, a school-led training course is for you. You're selected by the school and are based there during your training. You will also spend time in at least one other school to gain the broad experience required to become a teacher.

All school-led courses cover the practical and theoretical elements of teaching alongside University partners. Most school-led courses lead to a **postgraduate certificate in education (PGCE)** and/or master's-level credits, in addition to **qualified teacher status (QTS)**

2. Traditional Secondary PGCE (Post Graduate Certificate in Education)

Universities offer teacher training courses for both graduates and undergraduates. Universities work with groups of schools to offer at least two school experience placements as part of your training. Priory works in partnership with both Sussex and Brighton University.

If you want your teacher training to be based at a University, this is the option for you. A **PGCE** is available through all University led training
